#### **Responsibilities of Membership**

ECHHO is a non-profit organization that relies on volunteers to accomplish its goals of increasing awareness and participation in higher education by Latino students. Member institutions are expected to appoint a representative to: 1.) serve as a liaison to ECHHO, 2.) attend its college fairs and quarterly meetings, and 3.) assist with ECHHO programs and services.

#### **Membership Dues**

The membership year for ECHHO is September 1 through August 31. As of July 2005 the dues are as follows:

Four-Year Colleges/Universities** (public or private)	\$150.00
**Regional and branch campuses are expected to pay a separate fee	
Two-Year Colleges (community or technical, regional or branch campuses)	\$125.00
For Profit Businesses of Corporations	\$150.00
Additional Active Staff Dues	\$35.00
Associate Members (individuals not affiliated with a college or university)	\$35.00

#### **Dues Payment**

A check for membership, payable to ECHHO, must accompany the membership application. Payment and application must be received by August 31 in order to be included in the ECHHO membership directory. Send all items to the address listed on the membership application.
